We will seek new information each year. Your assessment of a child this year will not negatively affect that child in future years. We expect children to change.

2. Additional Information Respecting Players on Other Teams

If you are aware of any particularly dominant players on any of the other teams you have played or practiced with this year, it will help if you can also identify them for us.

The more information we have from different sources the better we can construct next season's teams.

3. Club Head Coach Evaluations

The Club's Head Coach will also provide coordinators with assessment information about players in your age group.

Re: U10: He will have seen the players throughout the year at the Common Practice sessions.

Re: U8 and U9: He will attend some games in February to observe the players.

Re: U6 and U7: Because of their very young age and the fact that they will especially change from one year to the next, the Head Coach will not especially observe games at year end for evaluations. He will though provide the coordinators with what observations he has made throughout the year respecting particularly dominant or weaker players (the main ones we need to identify so to best balance teams).
